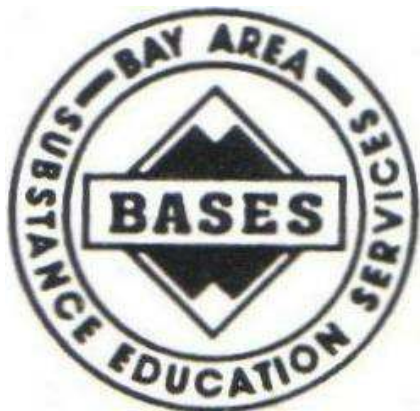

- ◆ **Life Skills Program** — Working with teens individually and in group settings in schools at Harbor Springs, Boyne City, Boyne City Alternative, Inland Lakes, Wolverine, Petoskey Alternative.
- ◆ **HEAL Program** — domestic violence groups for males Wednesdays 5:30-7:00 pm and Sundays from 12:00-1:30 pm
- ◆ **Jail Goups** — Weekly CBT/DBT educational groups for men and women in the Charlevoix County Jail.
- ◆ **New Groups**— Four weekly adult co-ed substance use disorder groups on Mondays and Wednesdays 10:15-11:45 am and Tuesdays and Thursdays 5:30-7:00 pm
- ◆ **Chronic Pain Group**— Monday, 4:00-5:30 pm. BASES offers a chronic pain group for those with substance use disorders.
- ◆ **Beaver Island Outpatient**—individual and group counseling available at Beaver Island Rural Health Center several times per month

- ◆ **Peer Recovery Coach Program** - we are continuing to develop a Recovery Coach program to continue to meet the needs of our community while networking with local medical providers

- ◆ Substance use disorder evaluations for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Individual outpatient counseling for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Group outpatient counseling for adults and adolescents
- ◆ Drug testing / breathalyzer testing for courts, employers, families and self
- ◆ Alcohol / Drug education classes for first-time offenders
- ◆ Secretary of State Driver's License Appeal Division (DLAD) substance use disorder evaluations
- ◆ Transportation assistance for counseling clients if you live in Charlevoix County
- ◆ Community presentations upon request
